



Covid -19 Information

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to let you know that we have had a confirmed case of Covid-19 within the school. This has been confirmed today and relates to a member of our admin team. Our admin team do not work directly with children and precautionary measures were taken earlier in the week. This confirmed case will not affect children attending school as normal for the rest of this week until we break for half term.



I have notified all of the relevant parties, including the Department for Education Coronavirus helpline and the local Health Protection team and their advice is that school can remain open as normal for your child.



We have taken the necessary responsive measures with deep-cleaning of the relevant areas and the isolation of the relevant people. Staff have access to all of the required Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and it is likely that in the coming weeks, the children and young people may be affected by staff looking different as they wear more PPE.
