Outreach Service Level Agreement 22/23

Initial support and guidance: (free)

- Meeting and consultation with key members of staff. Observation of a student and suggested strategies.
- Email and telephone support and consultation.
- School to send staff to Queensmill to spend time in autism specific setting.

Advance support:

- Secondment of a specialist member of Queensmill staff to facilitate and support existing staff in the setting for 1, 2, 3 or 4 days a week
- Specialised support plan for student and setting (a plan would be devised to cover one term) using the SECRTS framework to assess individual autism understanding and management and appropriate person-centred outcomes.
- Autism audit of school (1/2 days) (to look at an autistic learners 'school journey', assessing the environment and social/language demands across the school environment).
- Expert advice from a Queensmill Occupational Therapist and SLTs.

Fees: (1, 2, 3 or 4 days a week)

- One students: £225 per day (6/3 hours with student per day)
- Two students: £250 per day (3h with student per day)
- Three students: £300 per day (2 hours with each student per day)
- Four students: £450 per day (1.5 hours with each student per day)
- More than four students: £550 per day (Supervise practice and oversee all students)
- Add more students (No direct work with any student in particular): £100 per child.

Training package: (Currently we can only offer Bronze training)

- Bronze: £100
 - Introduction to autism or Autism awareness (1 hour training)
- Silver: £500
 - Introduction to autism or Autism awareness
 - Two from the following specific trainings:
 - Strategies and intervention in Autism (TEACCH) or PECs
 - Intensive interaction or So Safe
- Gold: £750
 - Introduction to autism
 - Strategies and intervention in Autism (TEACCH)
 - o PECS
 - So Safe
 - o Intensive interaction
